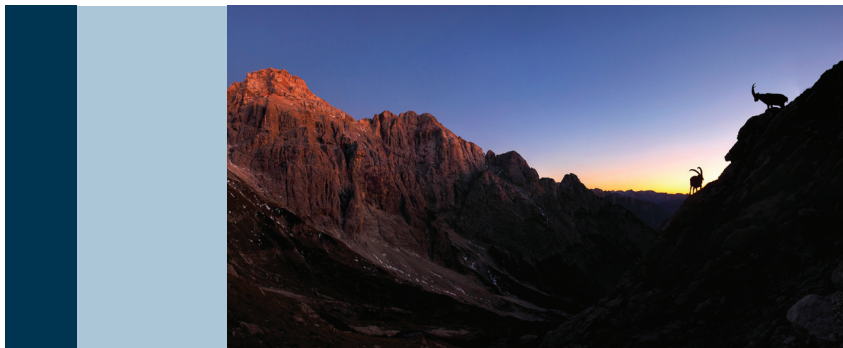

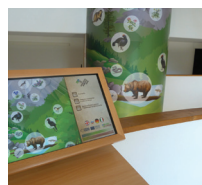

Dom Trenta (Trenta Lodge) provides visitors with information about the park and its surrounding areas, accommodation, and qualified guides for mountain tours of all levels of difficulty. The exhibitions and animated presentations highlight the beauty of Slovenia's only national park, as well as the cultural and ethnological heritage of the strong and independent Alpine man – an iron worker, an alpine dairy farmer, a lumberjack, a daring climber and a mountain guide.

- ◆ Life in the Trenta Valley in the past
